NATIONAL LOTTERY 'AWARDS FOR ALL' GRANT.

Bishop Lovett CE Middle School is proud to be the recipient of an 'Awards for All' National Lottery Grant. The grant will be used to fund a project which will commemorate and celebrate the life of this 'outstanding' school. The project will involve all members of the school, alongside the arts group 'Ecclestone George', and will take place during the week starting 27th June at Bishop Lovett Middle School. During the project, students will work together, firstly, to write, record and perform a school song, secondly, to direct and produce a music video and thirdly, to design a CD cover with an internal booklet comprising a short history of the school.

The project will culminate in presentations to the wider community and will provide every member of the school with a lasting memory of Bishop Lovett. We would like to thank the National Lottery 'Awards for All' funding body for this opportunity.
